- Students will go directly to their classroom and wash their hands, have a wellness screening, their temperature checked, and will be able to order their lunches. Pledges, Bible verses, and devotions will be done in the classroom.

- Per the state health department, when students are in their normal classrooms, around their regular peers, the classroom becomes an extension of their family and masks are **not** required. An effort should be made to social distance, but is **not** required.

- Per Governor Gordon we are no longer able to assemble together more than 50 students. That is why we will no longer be dropping children off at the gym door. Interaction with students in other classrooms will be minimized, but we will co-mingle with one other classroom for: breaks, lunches, PE, chapels, etc.

- Although face masks are **not** required in the classroom, we will be wearing them while in the hallways, per the Health Department.

- We will make every effort to maintain a clean and healthy environment, taking special care to clean throughout the day.

- Additional hand washing and cleanliness will be emphasized.
